ITEMS OF INTEREST

City Manager Graves gave the following report of the Planning Commission Meeting of August 10, 1981:

The Planning Commission -

1. After reviewing the report of the Public Works Department determined that no public need existed and recommended that the City Council abandon certain easements in Lots 30, 31, 32 and 42 of Lakeshore Village, Unit #1.
2. After reviewing the report of the Public Works Department which indicated that overhead power and CATV existed, the Planning Commission determined that a public need existed and recommended that the City retain the easement at 1206, 1218 and 1230 South Fairmont Avenue.

The report indicated that the new building location would be handled with an Encroachment Permit subject to the receipt of an easement to enable the City to extend existing 3 inch, deadend water line to Fairmont Avenue.
