

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council authorize the purchase of four leased replacement sedans approved in the 1982-83 Operating Budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The four approved sedans are for the following departments:

1. Police Department Captain
2. Public Works Street Supervisor
3. Community Development Chief Inspector
4. City Manager, Council

These sedans will be 1981-82 leased cars with maintenance and a one year warranty. Prices will be secured from local dealers, Hertz, Avis, Budget and National Car Leasing companies by the Building and Equipment Maintenance Supervisor.

PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AUTHORIZED

City Manager Glaves requested authority to replace two automobiles which are now considered beyond economic repair. The vehicles include one in the Police Department which was considered and approved for inclusion in the budget but was inadvertently left out of the budget submitted to the City Council, and one in the Parks Department which is used by the Park Patrol. The Police vehicle is used for undercover work and administrative travel and the vehicle used by the Park Patrol would be an extremely high mileage car.

On motion of Councilman Hughes, Murphy second, Council authorized the purchase of the following vehicles:

- a) Police vehicle \$8,000.00 - \$
 - b) Park vehicle \$5,800.00
- \$13,800.00

Following introduction of the matter by City Manager Glaves, Council, on motion of Mayor Pro Tempore Murphy, Hughes second, adopted revised job specifications for the Recreation Supervisor position.
