PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY hereby gives notice that in Application No. 60863 it has requested authorization under its Gas Adjustment Clause (GAC) to revise its gas service tariff effective October 1, 1981, to reflect gas costs and to amortize the balance in the Gas Cost Balance Account (GCBA).

The proposed rates would increase PGandE's gas revenues about 1.5 percent or \$54.5 million for the twelve-month period beginning October 1, 1981. The increase will not raise PGandE's Gas Department rate of return above the level of 10.3 percent last found just and reasonable for PGandE's Gas Department by the California Public Utilities Commission. PGandE is also proposing to modify the Gas Adjustment Cost Clause in its gas tariffs.

The State, the counties, the municipal corporations, and other parties interested in the above-mentioned filing will be furnished a copy of Application No. 60863 with related exhibits, upon written request made to PGandE, 77 Beale Street, P. O. Box 7442, San Francisco, California 94120, Attention: Daniel E. Gibson, Assistant General Counsel.
