An exhibit was presented for Council's perusal showing the proposed on-street parking layout which maintains the existing six parking stalls with one of those stalls designated for handicapped use.

Following discussion, with questions being directed to Staff, Council, on motion of Council Member Snider, Olson second, adopted Resolution No. 85-131 establishing one on-street parking space for handicapped persons on Central Avenue north of Vine Street.



SUBJECT: Central Avenue - North of Vine Street
Proposed On-Street Handicapped Parking Space

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That City Council establish one on-street parking space for handicapped persons on Central Avenue, north of Vine Street.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Dave Vera of R & D Orthopedic Laboratory notified Public Works staff that he would be leasing 840 and 842 Central Avenue as of September 1. Since many of the R & D Orthopedic Laboratory patients are handicapped, Public Works staff feels a handicapped space is appropriate. Exhibit A presents the proposed on-street parking layout which maintains the existing six parking stalls with one of those stalls designated for handicapped use. As shown, a five-foot wide zone adjacent to a handicapped stall will be installed for unloading and loading. The State of California Vehicle Code Section 22511.7 describes the parking requirements for disabled persons and Section 22652 describes the removal of unauthorized vehicles from handicapped persons parking spaces.




