Mr. Dennis Bennett, Chairman of the Old Lodi Union High School Site Foundation addressed the Council, giving an update on the activities of the Foundation and a report on Field and Fair Day V. Introduction of Foundation Members present were made. A check in the amount of \$67,000 was presented to the City by the Foundation which amount included:

\$33,677.00 from the Park West Home Sale

\$33,323.00 from private donations and contributions and Field and Fair Day V proceeds

\$322.18 credit for a glass show case

\$199.28 credit for signage

It was announced that with this contribution by the Foundation, that the amount still owing on the site purchase is \$29,974.54.

Council expressed its sincere appreciation to the members of the Foundation and all of those who have worked so hard toward accomplishing their goal.

On motion of Council Member Reid, Olson second, Council appropriated a matching sum of \$67,000, less an amount which had previously been advanced to the Foundation which amount is to be used for the building program at Hutchins Street Square. These funds are to be allocated from Capital Outlay Fund.




