
RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the bid for the 3 mid-size pickup trucks to Sanborn Chevrolet in the amount of \$26,866.72, which includes sales tax.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The specifications for these items were approved by the City Council on September 5, 1984. Bids were opened on Wednesday, October 3, 1984 and the following 5 bids were received.

Two of these pickups will be assigned to the Building Inspection Division of the Community Development Department, one as a replacement truck and the other as an additional vehicle for the newly hired Building Inspector. The third truck replaces a 1973 Ford Sedan assigned to a Public Works Inspector of the Public Works Department.

There was \$28,830 budgeted for these items in the 1984-85 budget.
