


Total Project Estimate: \$60,000

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above project and authorize advertisement for bids thereon.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project includes the installation of an additional storm drain outfall along the west bank of Lodi Lake. The present pump station outfall is near the swim area and is a nuisance when in use. The proposed outfall will carry all the discharge except during major storms when excess flow will divert to the present outfall. This should pose no problem since the swim area should not be in use during those times.

The project estimate is substantially less than the budgeted amount because the proposed project is shorter in length than originally conceived.


