REVENUE SHARING
APPROPRIATIONS 1982-83

Notice thereof having been published in accordance with law and affidavit of publishing being on file in the office of the City Clerk, Mayor Reid called for the Public Hearing to consider the proposed uses of Revenue Sharing Funds.

The matter was introduced by City Manager Graves who presented the following recommended Revenue Sharing Appropriations for 1982-83:

Capital Outlay

Storm Drainage	\$247,000
Other Facilities	<u>341,400</u>
	\$588,400
Classification and Salary Survey	25,000
City Telephone Study	<u>4,000</u>
	\$617,400

There being no persons in the audience wishing to speak on the matter, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Following discussion, on motion of Councilman Pinkerton, Murphy second, Council approved the Revenue Sharing Appropriations for 1982-83 as heretofore set forth.
