

ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 1270 - Ordinance amending the General Plan Land Use Element consisting of two sections:

GENERAL PLAN LAND USE
ELEMENT CONSISTING
OF TWO SECTIONS

Section 1 - Designating portions of Lobaugh Meadows, a proposed 91.17 acre development on the south side of West Kettleman Lane easterly of Lower Sacramento Road, as Medium Density Residential and Office-Institutional.

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ADOPTED

Section 2 - Redesignating the 9.96 acre parcel at the southwest corner of West Lodi Avenue and South Ham Lane from Medium Density Residential to Office-Institutional.

Having been introduced at a regular meeting held September 15, 1982 Ordinance No. 1270 was brought up for passage on motion of Council Member Pinkerton, Murphy second. Second reading was omitted after reading by title, and the Ordinance was then passed, adopted, and ordered to print by the following vote:

ORDINANCE NO. 1270

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF LODI BY a) DESIGNATING PORTIONS OF LOBAUGH MEADOWS, A PROPOSED 91.17 ACRE DEVELOPMENT ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST KETTLEMAN LANE EASTERLY OF LOWER SACRAMENTO ROAD, AS MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL AND OFFICE-INSTITUTIONAL AND b) REDESIGNATING THE 9.96 ACRE PARCEL AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF WEST LODI AVENUE AND SOUTH HAM LANE FROM MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO OFFICE-INSTITUTIONAL

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. - The Land Use Element of the General Plan of the City of Lodi is hereby amended by a) Designating portions of Lobaugh Meadows, a proposed 91.17 acre development on the south side of West Kettleman Lane easterly of Lower Sacramento Road, as Medium Density Residential and Office-Institutional, and b) redesignating the 9.96 acre parcel at the southwest corner of West Lodi Avenue and South Ham Lane from Medium Density Residential to Office-Institutional.

Section 2. - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. - This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi Life and Times", a twice weekly newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
