



**SUBJECT: Cluff Avenue/Turner Road Assessment District No. 1**

This letter is to confirm the intentions expressed at the City Council meeting of September 16, 1981, concerning your participation in the above District. The particulars are:

1. You are to dedicate the street right-of-way on Cluff Avenue
2. The City will pay for the installation of curb, gutter and sidewalk and water and sewer taps.
3. The District will install all the street paving on Cluff Avenue
4. The District will install the water and sewer mains.
5. Reimbursement agreements will be prepared so that if you obtain water and sewer service you will be charged for your share of these utilities
6. Your properties will not be included within the District boundaries and thus, not be assessed.

There is a question in the minds of some of the District proponents regarding Item 3. They indicated their willingness to pay for paving Cluff Avenue for only those properties included in the Sanitary City Annexation. This would exclude the Reynolds and LaMale properties. However, the resolution of this Item will be between the City and the District and will not affect you financially.

We understand you have right-of-way deeds that were furnished by the engineer for the District. We would appreciate receiving the signed deeds based on the items included in this letter. We will not record the deeds until the District is finally approved, hopefully at the next Council meeting on October 7, 1981.
