SUBJECT: SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF STREETLIGHT LUMINAIRES (EUD 86-9)

Specifications for the purchase of 160 100-watt and 20 250-watt High Pressure Sodium (HPS) streetlight luminaires are presented for Council's approval and permission to advertise for bids is requested. The bid opening date has been set for November 6, 1986.

The luminaires will be used in the City's streetlight conversion program from incandescent to HPS lighting and to maintain an inventory for other needs (maintenance requirements) as they develop.

The estimated cost of this purchase is \$16,000 with delivery expected in 6-8 weeks. Funding for this equipment was included in the Public Works Department's 1986-87 Operating Budget.
