Provide public transportation for an approximated population of 40,000. Based on the current modes of public transportation which are inefficient. We petition the Lodi City Council:

1. To recognize the need for a public shuttle bus service as a high priority.
2. To then be acted upon within a given date.
3. System as such to service the nine square miles within the city limits.
4. Economical and Efficient to all.

Following discussion, Mayor Snider directed the City Clerk to correspond with the person responsible for the circulation of the petition advising that the San Joaquin County Council of Governments will be holding an Urmet Transit Needs Hearing in Lodi within the next 60 days and suggesting that it would be appropriate for testimony regarding their concerns to be given at that time.


