RESOLUTION NO. 81-133

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI TO ABANDON THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY BOUNDED BY CHURCH STREET, OLIVE COURT, PLEASANT AVENUE AND DAISY AVENUE, LODI, CALIFORNIA

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi as follows:

SECTION 1. - It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Lodi, acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 8300 et seq of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, to vacate, close and abandon the north-south alley bounded by Church Street, Olive Court, Pleasant Avenue and Daisy Avenue, Lodi, situated in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

that 10.00 foot alley lying adjacent to Lots 3 and 4 as shown on map of RESUBDIVISION of the west half of Block 2, AYERS and PITCHERS ADDITION and filed for record July 3, 1913 in Volume 7, page 19, San Joaquin County Records.

Reference is hereby made to a map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk for particulars as to the proposed vacation.

SECTION 2. - Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby fix Wednesday, October 21, 1981,

at the hour of 8:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Lodi, California, as the time and place when and where all persons interested in or objecting to the vacation herein proposed may appear before the City Council and may be heard.

SECTION 3. - Upon adoption of this resolution the Director of Public Works shall post, or cause to be posted, notice of such passage and of the time and place set herein for public hearing, in accordance and in time, form, and manner as prescribed by law for the vacation of streets.

SECTION 4. - This resolution shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lodi, said publication to be completed at least fifteen days prior to said hearing.




