Council was apprised that the Public Works Department received a request from the Police Department to install a merge sign (W11) and arrow pavement markings on Turner Road east of Stockton Street. These signs can be installed without Council approval.

In evaluating this request, staff reviewed the existing striping and curb markings in this area. Turner Road at Stockton Street changes from five lanes (four through lanes and a turn lane) to three lanes (two through lanes and a turn lane). Staff felt it was appropriate to extend the four lanes to Wintun Drive due to the high traffic volume (11,300 vehicles per day). When the vacant commercial area on the north side of Turner Road west of Highway 99 develops, the "no parking" area will be needed for turn lanes.

Staff recommends installing a no parking zone from Stockton Street to Highway 99 to accommodate the proposed through lanes and the merge area. A no parking zone from Stockton Street to Sacramento Street is needed to accommodate the existing through lanes (14' wide).

Discussion followed with questions being directed to Staff.

On motion of Council Member Reid, Hinchman second, Council adopted Resolution No. 87-140 establishing a "No Parking" zone on Turner Road from Sacramento Street to Highway 99 on-ramp. At the suggestion of Council Member Reid, Council also directed staff to contact Cal Trans regarding the possibility of lengthening the right turn pocket in the subject area.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council establish a no parking zone on Turner Road from Sacramento Street to the Highway 99 on-ramp (see attached exhibit).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Public Works Department received a request from the Police Department to install a merge sign (W11) and arrow pavement markings on Turner Road east of Stockton Street. These signs can be installed without Council approval.

In evaluating this request, staff reviewed the existing striping and curb markings in this area.
