RECOMMENDED ACTION: That Council, by motion action, allow the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Lodi Post 1948, to tie red ribbons on all trees on School Street between Lodi Avenue and Lockeford Street, Lodi, during the week of November 9, 1987 to call attention to those missing in action and P.O.W.'s from World War II, the Korean War and Viet Nam.

Mr. Leland Fortner, representing the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Lodi Post 1948, has requested that the City Council take action to call attention to those missing in action and P.O.W.'s from World War II, the Korean War and Viet Nam. As in 1986, specifically the request was to tie red ribbons on all trees on School Street between Lodi Avenue and Lockeford Street. It was requested that the ribbons remain in place during the week of November 9, 1987.

The City encountered no problems last year, and it is recommended that Council, by motion action, grant this request.
