TO: THE STATE, COUNTY AND CITY OFFICIALS  
AND INTERESTED PARTIES

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY hereby gives notice that in Application No. 82 09 51 it has requested authorization effective December 1, 1982, to decrease electric rates under the ECAC tariff. PGandE also requests authority to establish an Electric Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (ERAM) rate in accordance with Public Utilities Commission Decision No. 93887.

The requested December 1 rate adjustments would decrease electric revenues about 9.4 percent or approximately \$371 million for the 12-month period beginning December 1, 1982.

The ECAC and other rate adjustments will not raise PGandE's Electric Department rate of return above the level of 12.2 percent last found reasonable for PGandE's Electric Department by the California Public Utilities Commission.
