other inflammable material within any park area or on any highway, road or street abutting or contiguous thereto. (Ord. No. 677, § 5.)

Sec. 15A-5. Entering closed areas.

No person shall be present in any park during the days and hours that such park is designated by the director as closed. Such days and hours shall be posted on signs at the entrances to such park.

Further, no person shall enter or be in an area posted as "Closed to the Public," nor shall any person use or abet the use of any such area in violation of the posted notices. (Ord. No. 677, § 5; Ord. No. 1078, § 1.)

Sec. 15A-6. Vending and peddling.

No person in a park shall, without the prior approval of the director, expose or offer for sale any article or thing, nor shall he station or place any stand, cart or vehicle for the transportation, sale or display of any such article or thing. Exception is here made as to any regularly licensed concessionaire acting by and under the authority and regulation of the director. (Ord. No. 677, § 6.)

Sec. 15A-7. Advertising.

No person in a park shall announce, advertise or call the public attention in any way to any article or service for sale or hire. (Ord. No. 677, § 6.)

Sec. 15A-8. Signs.

No person in a park shall paste, glue, tack or otherwise post any sign, placard, advertisement or inscription whatever, nor shall any person erect or cause to be erected any sign whatever on any public lands or highways or roads adjacent to a park. (Ord. No. 677, § 6.)
