Council was apprised that Christy Marion, 515 South Sacramento Street, Lodi, has requested the installation of the crosswalk at the west leg of the intersection as an aid to children crossing from the north side of Tokay Street to a school bus stop on the south side. The crosswalk on the south leg would be used by pedestrians crossing from the residential area west of Sacramento Street to the grocery and other businesses east of Sacramento Street. Council was apprised that Section 14-35 of the City Code establishes the City Council as the authority for the installation.

SUBJECT: Pedestrian Crosswalks @ Tokay & Sacramento

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution establishing crosswalks on the west side of Sacramento Street across Tokay Street, and on the south side of Tokay Street across Sacramento Street as shown on the attached exhibit.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Christy Marino, 515 South Sacramento Street has requested the installation of the crosswalk at the west leg of the intersection as an aid to children crossing from the north side of Tokay Street to a school bus stop on the south side. The crosswalk on the south leg would be used by pedestrians crossing from the residential area west of Sacramento Street to the grocery and other businesses east of Sacramento Street.


The following Section of the Lodi City Code establishes the City Council as the authority for the installation:

Sec. 14-35. Establishment, designation and maintenance of crosswalks.

The city council shall establish, designate and cause to be maintained crosswalks at intersections and other places by appropriate devices, marks or lines upon the surface of the roadway as follows:

Crosswalks shall be established and maintained at all intersections within the business district and at such other places within or outside the district where the city council determines that there are particular hazards to pedestrians crossing the roadway. (Ord. No. 493, § 110)

Primarily because of the school bus stop, this department feels it is a reasonable request and recommends its installation.


