RESOLUTION NO. 82-120

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PUBLIC PARKING LIMITS
AND PERMIT PARKING IN VARIOUS CITY-OWNED OR
CITY-OPERATED PARKING LOTS AND THEREBY RESCINDING
RESOLUTION NO. 81-176

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 1247, the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby establish public parking limits and permit parking in various City-owned or City-operated parking lots:

a) The following City-owned or City-operated parking lots are hereby defined for the purposes of Section 3 of the City Code of the City of Lodi:

- Lot 1 - Parking Lot No. 1 located at the northwest corner of Church Street and Walnut Street (Lot 8 and the west 40 feet of Lot 7, Block 8, City of Lodi)
- Lot 2 - Parking Lot No. 2 located on the south side of Oak Street between School Street and Church Street (Lot 2, Block 8, City of Lodi)
- Lot 3 - Parking Lot No. 3 located at the northeast corner of Church Street and Oak Street (Lot 8, Block 9, City of Lodi)
- Lot 4 - Parking Lot No. 4 located on the southeast corner of Church Street and Pine Street (Lot 1 and the west 30 feet of Lot 2, Block 9, City of Lodi)
- Lot 5 - Parking Lot No. 5 located on the northeast corner of Church Street and Elm Street (Lot 8, Lot 7, and the west 70 feet of Lot 6, Block 11, City of Lodi)

b) The following Lots or portions of Lots are hereby established as public parking for the maximum time of two hours:

1. The east half (two parking rows) of Lot 1;
2. Lot 2;

3. The east third (one parking row) of Lot 3;
4. The east half (two parking rows) of Lot 4.

c) The following Lot is hereby established as public parking for the maximum time of five hours:

1. The east 70 feet of Lot 5.

d) The following Lots or portions of Lots are hereby established as permit parking only:

1. The west half (two parking rows) of Lot 1;
2. None of Lot 2;
3. The west two-thirds (two parking rows) of Lot 3;
4. The west half (two parking rows) of Lot 4;
5. Lot 5 except the east 70 feet.

e) The requirements of parts (b), (c) and (d) above shall apply between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. except Sundays and holidays.

f) Parking permits for Lots described in part (d) above shall be sold by the Finance Director. The non-refundable charge for parking permits shall be \$5.00 per month, payable in advance.

g) Parking permits shall be displayed on the driver's side of the rear bumper.

Resolution No. 81-176 is rescinded effective the date of the adoption of this Resolution.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PUBLIC PARKING LIMITS
AND PERMIT PARKING IN VARIOUS CITY-OWNED OR
CITY-OPERATED PARKING LOTS AND THEREBY RESCINDING
RESOLUTION NO. 81-176

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 1247, the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby establish public parking limits and permit parking in various City-owned or City-operated parking lots:

a) The following City-owned or City-operated parking lots are hereby defined for the purposes of Section 3 of the City Code of the City of Lodi:

- Lot 1 - Parking Lot No. 1 located at the northwest corner of Church Street and Walnut Street (Lot 8 and the west 40 feet of Lot 7, Block 8, City of Lodi)
- Lot 2 - Parking Lot No. 2 located on the south side of Oak Street between School Street and Church Street (Lot 2, Block 8, City of Lodi)
- Lot 3 - Parking Lot No. 3 located at the northeast corner of Church Street and Oak Street (Lot 8, Block 9, City of Lodi)
- Lot 4 - Parking Lot No. 4 located on the southeast corner of Church Street and Pine Street (Lot 1 and the west 30 feet of Lot 2, Block 9, City of Lodi)
- Lot 5 - Parking Lot No. 5 located on the northeast corner of Church Street and Elm Street (Lot 8, Lot 7, and the west 70 feet of Lot 6, Block 11, City of Lodi)

b) The following Lots or portions of Lots are hereby established as public parking for the maximum time of two hours:

1. The east half (two parking rows) of Lot 1;
2. Lot 2;

3. The east third (one parking row) of Lot 3;
4. The east half (two parking rows) of Lot 4.

c) The following lot is hereby established as public parking for the maximum time of five hours:

1. The east 20 feet (one parking row) of Lot 5.

d) The following Lots or portions of Lots are hereby established as permit parking only:

1. The west half (two parking rows) of Lot 1;
2. None of Lot 2;
3. The west two-thirds (two parking rows) of Lot 3;
4. The west half (two parking rows) of Lot 4;
5. Lot 5 except the east 20 feet.

e) The requirements of parts (b), (c) and (d) above shall apply between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. except Sundays and holidays.

f) Parking permits for Lots described in part (d) above shall be sold by the Finance Director. The non-refundable charge for parking permits shall be \$5.00 per month, payable in advance.

g) Parking permits shall be displayed on the driver's side of the rear bumper.
