RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the bid for "Laboratory Expansion - White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility" to C. Edward Jones & Co., the low bidder, in the amount of base bid \$84,664.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Plans and specifications for this project were approved by the City Council on September 15, 1982. Bids were opened on Wednesday, October 20, 1982, and the following six bids were received:

A tabulation of the bids has also been attached. The Alternate No. 1 bid was for a concrete block column vs. a pour-in-place concrete column. Due to the small savings and the fact that a block column would not look the same as the other existing exterior columns, it is recommended that Alternate No. 1 not be considered.

This department has done a background check on the low bidder, and it is felt he should be awarded the bid.
