


CITY COUNCIL MEETING

November 4, 1981

PETITION RECEIVED City Clerk Reimche presented a petition which had been received
RE NO-PARKING ZONE from residents of South Sunset Drive, Lodi, requesting that
ON THE SOUTH-WEST a no-parking zone be established on the southwest corner of
CORNER OF LODI AVE. Lodi Avenue and South Sunset Drive to extend approximately 45
AND SOUTH SUNSET feet southward from Lodi Avenue. Mr. Manuel E. Rocha, Jr., 324
DRIVE S. Sunset Drive, Lodi, who was the circulator of the petition

to any of Council's questions regarding the matter. On motion
of Mayor Pro Tempore Murphy, Katnich second, Council referred
the matter to Staff and asked that Council be given a report

Whereas, a cement block fence permanently obscures driving vision around the corner proceeding East of Lodi Avenue and turning South onto South Sunset Drive,

and,

Whereas, parked recreational vehicles are commonly discovered on the same side of the street, while executing the above turn, causing one to swerve violently to the left and endangering on-coming traffic,

and,

Whereas, repeated circumvention and violation of R.V. parking ordinances demonstrates the bad faith of the owner of the vehicles, which are namely motorhomes and large boats,

and,

Whereas, it is felt by the undersigned that, if the above condition is allowed to continue a collision will eventually result, possibly ending in injury or death, and probably involving the residents of this street;

Therefore, we, the undersigned residents of South Sunset Drive, request that a no-parking zone be established on the Southwest corner of Lodi Avenue and South Sunset Drive to extend approximately 45 feet southward from Lodi Avenue.


Dear Mr. Rocha:
