Council was informed that the Engineering Division had received from Edwin Wall, Jr., the Purchasing Manager of Pacific Coast Producers, to establish a 25-foot no parking zone south of the driveway between the can plant and the cannery. Pacific Coast Producers has requested this zone to prevent employees from parking too close to the driveway. The large trucks using this driveway need the extra space to maneuver, and in recent months a number of cars have been hit by these trucks.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution establishing a no parking zone on South Stockton Street as shown on the attached sketch.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Engineering Division has received a request from Edwin Wall, Jr., the Purchasing Manager of Pacific Coast Producers, to establish a 25-foot no parking zone south of the driveway between the can plant and the cannery.

Pacific Coast Producers has requested this zone to prevent employees from parking too close to the driveway. The large trucks using this driveway need the extra space to maneuver, and in recent months a number of cars have been hit by these trucks.

The Engineering Division has evaluated this situation and recommends that Pacific Coast Producers' request be approved.


