


Subject: Notification from Lodi Ambulance Service (Life Medical Industries,

We are advising you with a thirty (30) day notification of a fee adjustment.

Due to an increase in operational expenses during the past nineteen (19) months and the projection for expanding systems we deem it necessary to adjust our fees.


Our future goals are to computerize our Communications Center. This will enable us to track our ambulances and systematically send the closest ambulance. We have added an additional ambulance to service the community due to an increase in simultaneous calls. However, we have not really generated any significant increase in patient transports. Our personnel costs and benefits have increased and will continue to do so during the next year.

We will be adjusting fees to the County maximum allowance except for mileage of which will be adjusted to \$7.00.

5.36.250 Rates to be charged for ambulance service.

A. The owner of every ambulance operating in the city shall file with his application for an ambulance operator's permit, a true and correct schedule of rates to be charged for the transportation of passengers in any and all vehicles operated by such operator. The rates shall not be changed or modified in any manner without first filing such changed or modified rates with the city clerk thirty days prior to the effective date of such change or modification.

B. The city council reserves the right to finally determine and fix by resolution, the rates to be charged by the operator of the ambulance service. (Ord. 1347 § 25, 1985)


Dear Ms. Hodge:
