Be It Ordained by the Lodi City Council.

SECTION 1. Chapter 12.12 Parks of the Lodi Municipal Code, is hereby amended to add a new section relating to swimming, bathing and/or wading, as follows:

"Section \_\_\_\_\_. No person in a park shall swim, bathe and/or wade in any waters or waterways in or adjacent to any park, except in areas which have been designated by the director as areas where said activity is allowed. The areas where swimming, bathing and/or wading is allowed shall have official signs erected, designating said areas, and giving notice that said activity is allowed."

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
