SUBJECT: Parking on North Side of Century Boulevard - Scarborough Drive


RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution prohibiting parking on the north side of Century Boulevard from Scarborough Drive to approximately 200 feet west of Scarborough Drive on school days between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m., and 12:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. (See attached EXHIBIT A.)

The Engineering Division also recommends that the request for parking restrictions along Scarborough Drive be denied.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Tim Haley, Property Manager of an apartment building at 1951 Scarborough Drive (Northwest corner of Century Boulevard and Scarborough Drive) has requested parking restrictions adjacent to the apartment on both Century Boulevard and Scarborough Drive (copy of letter attached). Tokay High School, like all other high schools in any community, has been noted for creating parking problems for its neighbors.

In November, 1977, the City Council adopted a resolution restricting parking on Dartmoor Circle and on the south side of Century Boulevard from Ham Lane to approximately 250 feet west of Scarborough Drive. In August, 1980, the limits of the restrictions were extended eastward to Scarborough Drive. The existing restrictions (prohibiting parking in adjacent residential areas from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m., and 12:30 to 2:30 p.m.) were adopted to prevent students from parking all day in front of homes in the area, but still not impose an extreme hardship on the residents since the restrictions apply to residents and their visitors as well as students.

Our observations of parking conditions at Mr. Haley's apartment complex indicate there is not a problem on Scarborough Drive at this time. If, at a later date, the extension of restrictions along Century Boulevard creates student parking problems on Scarborough Drive, additional restrictions can be considered.


