**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** That the City Council award the bid for Lane Line Painting and Removal of Miscellaneous Markings to Traffic Limited, Lodi, Ca., in the amount of \$15,939.14.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The specifications for "Lane Line Painting and Removal of Miscellaneous Markings" were approved by the City Council on October 27, 1982. Bids were opened on Wednesday, November 10, 1982, and three bids were received. The cost of painting a mile of lane lines is approximately the same as the 1981 bid.

The 1982-83 Operating Maintenance budget includes \$13,350 for painting of lane lines; however, when the 1982-83 budget was formulated, we did not anticipate removal of various pavement markings on Cherokee Lane. Removal of the existing lane lines, Vine Street south to Delores Street, and painting a federal left hand turning lane will provide safer turning movements to enter the business establishments within that block. A Special Allocation will be submitted to the City Manager in the amount of \$2,600 upon approval of the bid.
