The third phase has now been extended back to eighteen months; however, the City match requirements remain the same. The total City match of \$51,254 for Phase III. The hard match funds needed for F.Y. 87-88 have already been approved by the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief of Police of the City of Lodi Police Department is authorized, on its behalf to submit the attached proposal to OCJP and is authorized to execute on behalf of the City Council of the City of Lodi the attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the program and the rules and regulations of OCJP and that funds will be appropriated as required.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.


