On Thursday, November 6, 1986, bids were received for 160 100-watt and 20 250-watt High Pressure Sodium (HPS) streetlight luminaires. The luminaires will be used in the City's streetlight conversion program from incandescent to HPS lighting and to maintain an inventory for other needs (maintenance requirements) as they develop.

Based on the bids received, it is recommended that the bid be awarded to the lowest bidder in all categories, namely, General Electric Supply Co., Emeryville, in the total amount of \$12,168.80.
