WHEREAS, Section 22808 of the State of California Elections Code provides that a City may by ordinance or resolution limit campaign contributions in municipal elections.

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lodi following review of the matter does hereby determine that no limit shall be set on campaign contributions for the April 12, 1988 General Municipal Election.


