RECOMMENDED ACTION: Introduce an urgency ordinance amending Title 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.020.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: At the last City Council meeting, we discussed the amendments to the Brown Act. I inadvertently forgot to ask you to introduce the ordinance which would amend the Lodi Municipal Code by adding the verbage that no formal action shall be taken by the City Council at informal informational meetings. Under State law, agendas must be prepared for every council meeting and posted 72 hours in advance of said meeting. In order for our ordinance to comply with this law, I am asking that Council introduce the ordinance as an urgency ordinance. The reason this must be an urgency ordinance is because the ordinance must be in place by January 1, 1987 and there will not be enough time to introduce and later adopt the ordinance and allow it to be in effect by January 1.

ORDINANCE NO. 1395

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI
AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.04, SECTION 2.04.020 OF THE
LODI MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO INFORMAL INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL.

SECTION 1. Lodi Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:


"Informal informational meetings of the city council shall be held on each Tuesday morning of each month at the hour of seven a.m. in the council chambers of the city. No formal action shall be taken by the City Council at such meeting. The city manager, department heads and members of the public, as the council may request, shall be present and present such information as may be deemed desirable."

SECTION 2. The amended Section 2.04.020 hereinabove shall become effective January 1, 1987.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 4. This urgency ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect immediately.
