The Election Supply firm of Martin and Chapman Company has furnished the City of Lodi with an estimate for their company to provide certain services and supplies for the April 8, 1986 General Municipal Election. This would include providing all forms pertaining to the nomination process, absentee voting, polling places, precinct supplies, the printing, addressing and mailing of sample ballots, the printing of the official ballots, the providing of official canvass sets and other such services as are required by law.

Their estimate for these services is approximately \$11,000 based on the 20,500 voters registered for the November 5, 1985 election.

The Martin and Chapman Company is well known throughout the State of California and is highly recommended by cities throughout the State who use its services.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:
