

SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF 15-KV XLP CABLE (UD-E84-11)

On Tuesday, November 20, 1984, bids were received for 28,000 feet of #2 Aluminum 15-kv XLP concentric neutral cable. The cable will be used in Burgundy Village, Meadows, Rivergate, Whispering Oaks and Woodlake North Subdivisions, as well as Woodbrook Apartments and for other cable needs as they develop.

Based on the bids received, it is recommended that the bid be awarded to the lowest bidder Westinghouse Electric Supply Co. in the amount of \$17,036.32.
