Council was apprised that Homer Beldt, owner of Casa de Lodi, has requested no parking zones on the south side of Turner Road from the Casa de Lodi driveway to 200 feet east and between the driveway and Beckman Road to the west. The zones would provide sight distance for motorists exiting the mobile home park onto Turner Road.

The proposed No Parking Zones will provide residents of Casa de Lodi with essentially the same sight distance afforded any other motorist driving a typical City of Lodi residential street. Because of the number of motorists using the driveway, curve of the street and the existing speed zone of 45 mph, it is recommended that parking be restricted on both sides of the driveway.



SUBJECT: Resolution Prohibiting Parking -
Turner Road Driveway at Casa de Lodi

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution prohibiting parking on both sides of the Turner Road driveway of Casa de Lodi, as shown on the attached sketch (Exhibit A).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Homer Beldt, owner of Casa de Lodi, has requested no parking zones on the south side of Turner Road from the Casa de Lodi driveway to 200 feet east and between the driveway and Beckman Road to the west. The zones would provide sight distance for motorists exiting the mobile home park onto Turner Road.

The proposed No Parking Zones shown on Exhibit A (20 feet on each side of the driveway) will provide residents of Casa de Lodi with essentially the same sight distance afforded any other motorist driving a typical City of Lodi residential street (See Exhibit B). Because of the number of motorists using the driveway, curve of the street and the existing speed zone of 45 mph, it is recommended that parking be restricted on both sides of the driveway.




NO PARKING ZONES
