DIAL-A-RIDE CONTRACT

City Manager Peterson announced that this Special Meeting of the Lodi City Council, properly noticed, was called to discuss the current status of the City's contract with City Cab Company for the company's operation of the Dial-A-Ride program. Assistant City Manager Glenn informed the City Council that he had learned that City Cab Company carried no Workers' Compensation insurance. City staff deemed this to be a material and intentional breach of the terms and conditions of the contract. The Council was advised that the owner-operator of City Cab Company, Mr. Raymond Neel, was notified by letter that effective Tuesday, September 8, 1992 at 7:00 p.m., the contract was cancelled.

Mr. Glenn said that in this emergency the City was temporarily assuming the responsibility of operating the Dial-A-Ride program effective Thursday, September 10, 1992 at 7:00 a.m. He asked that the City Council authorize the hiring on a contract basis the present Dial-A-Ride dispatchers and drivers, and that the Council concur in the action of the City Manager in terminating the contract. On motion of Mayor Pinkerton, Hinchman second, the Council concurred in the actions enumerated above.
