The topic of discussion was the review of the City of Lodi Draft General Plan - Circulation, Noise and Conservation.

Addressing the City Council and Planning Commission regarding the subject were Debra D. Loh of Jones and Stokes Associates, Inc., and Valerie Rosencrantz of TJKM who had been involved in the preparation of the Public Review Draft.

The implementation programs for the various goals and policies of the Circulation element set forth in the proposed General Plan were reviewed in depth by Ms. Rosencrantz.

Questions were then directed to both Valarie Rosencrantz and Assistant City Engineer Richard Prima by the City Council, the Planning Commission and the public.

The Noise element of the Public Review Draft General Plan was then reviewed by Debra Loh of Jones and Stokes Associates, Inc. Ms. Loh went over the goals and policies of the Noise Element with discussion of noise relating to new developments.

The City Attorney informed Ms. Loh that the City of Lodi has a Noise Ordinance and was instructed to forward a copy of that ordinance to her.

The topic was then open for discussion with the Council, Planning Commission and the public.


