JUNE 14, 1978

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Lodi was held pursuant to written notice being mailed to each member of the City Council, KCRA TV News, the Lodi News Sentinel, the Lodi Life and Times, the Stockton Record, Lodi Cable TV, and KCVR Radio Station at least 24 hours prior to the meeting in compliance with Section 54956 of the California Government Code.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Pinkerton.

1978-79 BUDGET Assistant City Manager Glenn continued his presentation of the proposed 1978-79 Budget.

A revised Schedule B - (page 2) was presented to the Council.

Council was advised that the proposed Budget had been prepared prior to the passage of Proposition 13, and the estimated revenue from property tax would now have to be adjusted downward.

Schedule B reflected this revised projection.

Questions concerning the accounting procedures used for the Electric Utility Budget and the Utility Outlay Budget were posed by Councilman Hughes.

Councilman Hughes emphasized the Council's need to have the 5-year projection figures which had previously been requested.
