

**COUNCIL CHAMBERS CITY COUNCIL
CITY HALL - CITY OF LODI
THURSDAY, JUNE 2, 1949**

In accordance with the adjournment taken from its regular meeting of June 1, 1949, the City Council of the City of Lodi met in the Council Chambers at 5:00 P.M. of Thursday, June 2, 1949.

Councilmen Haskell, Bull, Tolliver, Lytle and Rinn present, none absent.

Mayor Rinn announced the purpose of this meeting as being for the consideration of bids opened May 25th for the construction of additional seats at Lodi Stadium, reading a letter from the Chief Examiner of the State Contractors License Board in which the opinion was expressed that, after viewing the plans and reading the specifications, that this work was principally concrete and that Mr William Burkhardt was qualified to bid on its construction.

The City Council remained in session awaiting the presence of Mr J. F. Watson, who had raised the point regarding Burkhardt's right to bid, until 8:30 o'clock P.M. when adjournment was taken to 9:00 A.M. of Friday, June 3, 1949 on motion of Councilman Bull.

FRIDAY - JUNE 3, 1949.

This second adjournment from its regular meeting of June 1st, 1949 was held in the City Council Chambers beginning at 9:00 A.M. of Friday, June 3, 1949, Councilmen Bull, Haskell, Lytle, Tolliver and Rinn present.

Messrs Burkhardt and Watson being in attendance. For the benefit of Mr Watson, Mayor Rinn again read the statement of the State Contractors License Board. Mr Watson expressed his satisfaction with this ruling, stating that this letter cleared up the point he had raised.

Mayor Rinn also read a letter from bidder, William Burkhardt, stating that if awarding this contract to himself would delay the work, he desired to withdraw his bid.

On examination of Mr Burkhardt, the Council was satisfied that he could procure the materials and perform the work within the time limit set by the specifications and it was moved by Councilman Tolliver, Lytle second, that award be made to William Burkhardt for concrete supported seats at the price named in his proposal opened May 25, 1949 by the adoption of Resolution of Award No. 1476. A vote being had on the adoption of this Resolution, all Councilmen voted in favor of the same and award was so made.

At 9:47 o'clock A.M. the City Council adjourned.
