WEDNESDAY, JULY 23, 1941.

Pursuant to the adjournment taken from its regular meeting of July 16, 1941, the City Council of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the place and on the date first above in these minutes written, Councilmen Bull, Riggs, Weihe and Steele present, Councilman Graffigna absent, being reported seriously ill.

The minutes of the last meeting held July 16th were read, approved as read and so endorsed by the Mayor.

After further consideration of bids opened July 16th on radio apparatus for the Police Department and after hearing recommendations from the City Engineer's Department, award as to items I and II of the Specifications was made to Brunton's Automotive Service of San Francisco, and as to Lampkin Laboratories of Bradenton, Florida as to Item IV by the adoption of Resolution of Award No. 1086 by the following vote:

AYES: Councilmen, Steele, Riggs, Weihe and Bull
NCES: Councilmen, None. ABSENT: Councilman Graffigna.

ORDINANCE NO. 273, entitled "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A LOCAL DEFENSE COUNCIL AND PRESCRIBING ITS DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES" having been regularly introduced on July 16th, 1941 as an emergency ordinance, was brought up for adoption on motion of Councilman Weihe, Riggs second, second reading omitted by unanimous vote of all members of the Council present, and finally passed, adopted and ordered to print by the following vote:-

AYES: Councilmen, Weihe, Riggs, Bull and Steele.
NCES: Councilmen, None. ABSENT: Councilman, Graffigna.

Notices of transfer of liquor licenses held by Joe Teresi to Salvatore Teresi at 314 East Lodi Avenue were received from the State Board of Equalization.

Business license applications of F.S. Rasco Company and of Lona Jobe, numbered 297 and 298 were allowed and licenses ordered granted.

The Council approved the renting of a parcel of ground south of the Sewage Disposal Plant to William Hildenbrand at an annual rental of \$15.00 per year to be on written agreement especially providing that the land be kept clean and clear of weeds.

On motion made, second and carried, the City Clerk was instructed to pay the sum of \$300.00 to Tokay Band for July concerts, such payment to be made from the "Revolving Fund" in his custody.

An agreement with the Division of Highways for expenditure of $\frac{1}{4}$ gasoline taxes on State Highways in the City for the fiscal year 1941-42 was approved by the adoption of Resolution No. 1082 by the following vote:

AYES: Councilmen, Riggs, Weihe, Bull and Steele.
NCES: Councilmen, None. ABSENT: Councilman, Graffigna.

The offer of Ben Scott to convey a strip of land fifty feet in width across his property in "Beckman Subdivision" for the opening of Park Street westerly to Hutchins Street for the sum of \$650.00 was taken under advisement.

At 9:45 o'clock, the Mayor called the City Council into executive session as Committee of the Whole, returning to regular session at 10:30 o'clock P.M.

Conforming to the provisions of Ordinance No. 273, the Mayor made the following appointments to the Local Defense Council created thereby:

As Vice-chairman, Councilman W. E. Riggs.

As Chairman of the Committee on Civil Protection, Police Chief C. S. Jackson and as members of this Committee, Mr Millard Fore and Mr Glenn West.

As Chairman of the Committee on Human Resources and Skills, Councilman C.B. Buland as members, Mr Hugh A. Dow and Walter Curtis.

The above appointments were approved by unanimous consent of all members of the City Council present.

On motion of Councilman Weihe, Riggs second, the City Clerk was permitted to make salary adjustments in his office amounting to \$40.00 monthly, as follows:-


The salary of Effie L. Griffin	Deputy Clerk to be \$ 175.00
