WEDNESDAY, MARCH 8, 1944

Pursuant to the adjournment taken from it's regular meeting of March 1, 1944, the City Council of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular meeting at 5:30 o'clock P.M. of Wednesday, March 8, 1944, Councilmen W.J.Coffield, W.E. Riggs, I.A.Spooner, Otto A. Weihe and Robert H. Rinn (Mayor) present, none absent.

ORDINANCE NO. 300, entitled, " AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE CITY CLERK AND OF THE CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LODI, AND REPEALING ALL FORMER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH ", introduced March 1, 1944, was brought up for passage on motion of Councilman Coffield, Spooner second, and, after reading by title, second reading was omitted by unanimous consent and the said Ordinance No 300 was passed, adopted and ordered to print by the following vote:-

AYES: Councilmen, Coffield, Spooner, Riggs, Weihe and Mayor Rinn. (5)
NOES: Councilmen, None (0)
ABSENT: Councilmen, None (0)

The Mayor then signed the ordinance in approval thereof.

Councilman Spooner reported that he, in company with the Assistant City Engineer had viewed the vines and trees growing on the westerly eighty feet of Lot 14, Live Oak Colony, Map No 1. and recommended that the rental of this strip of land be fixed at not less than \$350.00 for the year 1944.

At the direction of the Mayor, the City Clerk was directed to request an accounting from Glenn R. Houston for the crop grown of this land in 1942 and 1943 and also to notify Mr Lewis Sherman that, if he desired to rent this land for the current year, he should submit an offer in writing to the City Council.

Claims in the amount of \$11,207.17 as approved by a majority of the Finance Committee were allowed and ordered paid on motion of Councilman Coffield, Spooner second. (These are claims that normally would have been allowed at the regular meeting of March 1, 1944 but delayed in preparation for audit because this meeting date fell upon the first day of the month)

On motion of Councilman Spooner the City Council adjourned at 5:50 o'clock P.M.
