On application, Fire Chief Polenske was allowed to use one of the City Fire Trucks in the Armistice Day parade.

Mr Don Tonini addressed the Council regarding efforts to be made by the Boy Scouts to accumulate wood for a public wood yard for the benefit of unemployed transients.

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of October and the report of the City Poundmaster for the same period was read and ordered filed.

Supt. of Streets, B.C.Dougherty addressed the Council in regard to the wood from trimming street trees. This matter was referred to the local welfare board.


Bills in the amount of \$24,886.60 as approved by the finance committee were allowed and ordered paid on motion ofm Councilman Roach, Weihe second.
