The minutes of the last meeting held February 1st were read, approved as read and so endorsed by the Mayor.


No persons being in attendance, the order of Public Hearings was passed and the Council proceeded to hear communications; Union Oil Company of California applied for permission to place and operate two one-thousand gallon gasoline tanks, one at School and Elm and one at Elm & Sacramento Streets; Texas Company applied for permission to place a five hundred-fifty gallon gasoline tank at Elm & Cherokee. All applications granted.

A receipt for refund on premium from State Compensation was ordered filed.


Seven building permits for structures to cost \$4,200.00 were ordered granted.
