

City Hall, City of Lodi  
Tuesday April 26-1921

As per adjournment taken on the day previous, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session at 1.30 P.M. and on call of the roll there were present Trustees, Montgomery, Crose, Hickok and Rich. Trustee Hale absent being out of the city.

As agreed, the Board then took up the consideration of the proposals for the furnishing of pipe, valves and hydrants and on motion of Trustee Rich, seconded by Trustee Hickok, all bids were declared rejected except those of the American Cast Iron Pipe Co., American Machine Co., Crane Co., Kennedy Valve Co., and the Water Works Supply Co. which bids were held for further consideration and advisement until the next regular meeting.

On motion of Trustee Crose, seconded by Trustee Hickok, the Board granted the American Legion to hold a display of fireworks at Lawrence Park on May 11th.

The proposed extension of sewers along West Street was referred to the City Engineer for his recommendation.

The Board decided to paint the outside of the baths on motion of Trustee Crose, seconded by Trustee Rich.

At the order of the President, none dissenting, the board then adjourned.
