

City Hall, City of Lodi,
Monday August 22-1921

Pursuant to adjournment taken from the adjourned regular meeting of August 17th, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session at 8 o'clock P.M. and on call of the roll there were present Trustees Montgomery, Crose, Hickok and Rich; Trustee Hale absent.

The minutes of August 17th. were approved after the addition of the words "et al" after the name of Jacob Gatzert in the matter of the alley abandonment in the Marchand Addition.

Application for the position of City Marshal signed by W.J.Alcorn and For appointment as a deputy marshal signed by S.H.Byas received and ordered filed.

Two building permits granted for buildings at an estimated cost of \$10,000 and permission to bring in a house from without the city and locate same on De Force Avenue allowed.

Trustee Crose introduced Resolution No.175 rescinding formerly passed Resolution No.157 relating to the adoption of the assessment diagram for the improvement of Oak Street under abandoned Resolution of Intention No.37 and the same was adopted by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees, Crose, Hickok, Rich and Montgomery.
Noes, Trustees, None. Absent, Trustee, Hale.

The Board then adopted Resolution No.173, "A Resolution Approving the Diagram Showing the District Affected by the Improvement of Oak Street from the East Line of Sacramento Street to a line 125 ft. East and Parallel Thereto", by the following vote:-

Ayes, Trustees, Crose, Hickok, Rich and Montgomery.
Noes, Trustees, None.
Absent, Trustee, Hale.

Resolution No. 177, a "Resolution Rescinding Resolution of Intention No.39 " was then introduced and passed by the following vote: **

Ayes, Trustees, Crose, Hickok, Rich and Montgomery.
Noes, Trustees, None. Absent, Trustee, Hale.

On recommendation of the City Engineer, the City Clerk was directed to advertise for the following material and labor: Alternate bids for storm sewer pipe of either S.G.V. or Concrete pipe for Elm, Church, Lockeford and N.Sacramento Street in dimensions to be stated by the City Engineer; for the excavating of trench for same, the laying and back-filling trenches or for proposals for the pipe, excavation and filling combined.

After discussion, it was decided to take steps to abandon proceedings under the present Resolution of Intention on Lockeford Street and the City Attorney and City Engineer were directed to take steps to start new proceedings and exclude from the distric that part of Lockeford Street West of Church Street.

The board adjourned until Monday August 29, 1921 at 8.00 P.M.
