Wednesday August 31, 1921.

Pursuant to adjournment of August 29th, 1921, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session at 8 O'clock P.M. and on call of the roll there were present Trustees Montgomery, Crose, Hale, Hickok and Rich.

The clerk being out of the City, Trustee Rich was chosen clerk pro tem and the board proceeded to further consideration of the matter of the purchase of fire apparatus. The board having viewed apparatus of diverse makes on the preceeding day in Oakland and Berkeley and having had demonstration of one make within the city, due consideration having been given to all the types on which bids were submitted, the award for furnishing a completely equipped triple combination truck was awarded to the Seagrave Company by the introduction and passage of Resolution of Award No. 180 by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees, Hickok, Rich, Crose, Hale and Montgomery.  
Noes, None. Absent, None.

The Superintendent of Public Utilities was authorized to purchase 1750 feet of 8 inch cast iron pipe to be laid on the East line of Sacramento Street.

The bill of the City Transfer Company in the amount of \$264.91 and the bill of J.A. Henning for \$14.75 were allowed on motion properly made and seconded.

No other business appearing, the board adjourned to the date of the next regular meeting.
