

City Hall, City of Lodi,  
Thursday February 25-1922.

As per adjournment taken by the Clerk as stated above under the date of February 20, 1922, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session at 8 o'clock P.M. and on call of the roll, Trustees, Montgomery, Crose, Hale and Hickok were present, Trustee Rich absent.

The minutes of the regular meeting of February 6th., 1922 and the certificate of the clerk as to the adjournment from the meeting scheduled for February 20th were approved as read.

Diagrams delineating the districts to be assessed for the improvement of Tokay Street and Sacramento Street having been prepared by the City Engineer, the same were adopted by the following votes:-

Resolution No. 223, approving the diagram for Tokay Street:  
AYES: Trustees, Crose, Hickok, Hale, Montgomery.  
NOES: Trustees, None. ABSENT: Trustee, Rich.

Resolution No. 224, approving diagram for Sacramento St.:  
AYES: Trustees, Hickok, Crose, Hale, Montgomery.  
NOES: Trustees, None. ABSENT: Trustee, Rich.

Plans and specifications as prepared under order of the Board for the above named streets were approved and adopted by the passage of:-

Resolution No. 225 approving P. & S. Tokay Street;  
AYES: Trustees, Hale, Hickok, Crose, Montgomery.  
NOES: Trustees, None. ABSENT: Trustee Rich.  
Resolution No. 226, approving P. & S. Sacramento Street;  
AYES: Trustees, Crose, Hickok, Hale, Montgomery  
NOES: Trustees, None. ABSENT: Trustee, Rich.

Petitions asking the improvement of Rose and Locust Streets having been previously filed with the clerk and having his certificate attached stating that the signed frontage exceeded 50% of the total frontage, were referred to the Engineer for plans and specifications on motion of Trustee Hickok.

F.C. Ross applied for a license to conduct a card room at #15 West Pine Street under the provisions of subdivision 19 of Ordinance 82; Trustee Hale moved that the license be granted but receiving no second the motion was declared lost. Trustee Hickok, seconded by Trustee Crose moved that no more card room licenses be granted after expiration of present licenses and that the City Attorney be instructed to prepare an ordinance rescinding that portion of Ordinance No. 82 granting such licenses. The motion carried, Trustee Hale voting no.

Eight building permits were granted amounting to \$9,400.00
