

Municipal Building, Lodi, Cal., August 19, 1918

In regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi there were present Trustees Black, Hale, Crose and Montgomery. Absent Trustee Keeney.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

ORDINANCE NO. 103,

"An Ordinance Amending Subdivision Nine of Section Fourteen of Ordinance Number Eighty-Two, Providing for License Tax on Dogs," having been introduced August 5th and laid on the table for not less than five days, coming up regularly for final consideration, Trustee Montgomery moved its adoption as read, Trustee Crose seconded the motion, which was carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Trustees Montgomery, Crose Hale and Black.

Noes: None.

Absent: Trustee Keeney.

Upon motion the President of the Board was authorized to sign the conservation of materials pledge required by the War Industries Board.

Miscellaneous claims amounting to \$690.37 having been passed by the auditing committee were upon motion allowed and ordered paid.

Upon motion regularly made, seconded and carried, the Board adjourned to meet again at 7:30 p.m. August 26th, 1918.
