

City Hall, Lodi, Cal., December 20, 1920.

In regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, held the date above written, there were present Trustees Montgomery, Hale, Crose and Hickok. Absent Trustee Rich.

Minutes of the adjourned regular meeting of December 13th, were read and approved.

A petition was filed signed by the owners of all the property fronting on the alley running east and west through a portion of block 11, Hutchins Addition, from Lee Avenue to Hutchins Street, asking the Board to order the paving of said alley. The Clerk was instructed to notify petitioners that as soon as the City is in position to install the necessary water pipes a permit would be granted to pave said alley by private contract.

North River Insurance Company's policy No. AC83496, covering \$2500 on the City's fire truck, presented by V. R. Larson, was accepted.

In the matter of a proposed new tax ordinance it was decided to wait until Trustee Rich could be present before taking any definite action.

The City Engineer was instructed to establish the lines of an alley running east and west through block 2, Barnhart Tract, it having been reported to the Board that fences and buildings were encroaching on the public highway.

Ten applications for building permits were read, granted and ordered filed.

Miscellaneous bills amounting to \$2639.36, having been passed by the auditing committee, were allowed and ordered paid.
