

Municipal Building Lodi Cal. March 23rd. 1914 .

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi met in adjourned regular session with the following Trustees present, C.A. Black, J.M. Blodgett and F.O. Hale. President Lawrence was absent.

On motion regularly made and carried Trustee J.M. Blodgett was chosen President Pro-Tem.

The minutes of Mch. 16th. were read and approved. Building permits were granted to Henry Frey-W.D. Voornies & Son-F.E. Freeman-Fred. Scholl E.L. VanBuskirk and A.E. McNies. A communication from the Aetna Insurance Company in regard to burglar insurance was read and ordered filed. A communication from the State Compensation Insurance Fund was read and the Clerk instructed to get further information in regard to the matter. The resignation of Mr. Joe. Dotson as Pound Master was read and accepted. A report from City Engineer L.F. Barzillotti in regard to curbs on West Elm St. was read and ~~####~~ filed and no action taken. The President was authorized by motion to endorse a check from the New Amsterdam Casualty Co. for \$13.50 and make it payable to Dr. J.E. Nelson for services rendered to C.R. Griffith.

A motion was made by C.A. Black authorizing Frank O. Hale to procure Eucalyptus trees and have them planted on the south end of the City Sewer Farm along the Kettleman Lane, the motion carried unanimously.

The Board adjourned.
