

Municipal Building, April 20, 1914.

The first meeting of the New Board of Trustees elected April 13, 1914, convened in regular session at 10:30 p.m., there being present F. O. Hale, C. A. Black, Max Polendorf, E. M. Keeney, and E. B. Deaver.

The meeting was called to order by the City Clerk. F. O. Hale was unanimously elected President of the Board.

The bond of City Clerk was presented, approved and filed with the President of the Board.

A committee of three consisting of Trustees Black, Deaver and Keeney was appointed to draft suitable resolutions of appreciation to be presented to the retiring city officers.

Upon motion regularly made and seconded the City Engineer was instructed to ascertain the width of sidewalk required to clear trees in the matter of paving East Pine street.

Upon motion of Deaver, seconded by Black, the Clerk was instructed to prepare an ordinance amending section No. 2 of Ordinance No. 58, giving proper width of street paving and sidewalks to clear shade trees, the ordinance to be published in the Lodi Sentinel.

Upon motion the Board adjourned to meet again at 8 p.m. April 21, 1914.
