

Municipal Building, Lodi, Cal. April 19, 1916.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened at 8:00 p. m. pursuant to adjournment of April 17th. There were present Trustees Hale, Black, Keeney, Deaver and Folendorf.

Minutes of the two previous meetings were read and approved.

A permit was granted to E. R. McClure to construct addition to a dwelling at 228 North Cherokee street.

Upon motion of Trustee Keeney, seconded by Trustee Black, the Clerk was instructed to request members of the Board of Freeholders-elect to meet at the City Hall Monday evening, April 24th, at 8:00 o'clock to subscribe to the oath of office and organize.

The Board and others present discussed informally the question of the purchase of the Church of God grove for a park and location for the swimming tank.

Trustee Black filed with the Clerk a written option, good to May 1st, 1916, for the purchase of the above mentioned property at a price of \$8000.

J. G. Handel submitted propositions to sell to the city lands in the Moran-Handel Addition and filed plats of the same, showing locations dimensions and prices.

The Board adjourned to meet again Friday, April 21st, 1916, at 8:00 p. m.
